Prior to his current coaching role at Dickinson, Brian served in numerous coaching capacities, the two most prominent being, the Assistant Men's Soccer Coach at McDaniel College (formerly known as Western Maryland), for nine years, and as a head coach in the Maryland Olympic Development Program for three years.
