




GOULDING'S LODGE



Susan Rose '77, P'13 is Charles A. Dana Professor of Sociology and Director of Community Studies and Mosaic Programs. Her recent work focuses on the Carlisle Indian School and Indigenous Studies. As co-director of the Carlisle Indian School Digital Resource Center, she has had the opportunity



to visit with many Native communities across the country. Her fourth book, *Carlisle Indian Industrial School: Indigenous Histories, Memories, and Reclamations*, was named one of the best books of 2016 by the Philadelphia Inquirer. Her fieldwork in numerous countries on various topics has resulted in many articles, books and documentary films. Rose is a recipient of the Michael Harrington Distinguished Teaching Award from the National Poverty Forum and the National Oral History Distinguished Teaching Award, as well as Dickinson's Distinguished Teaching Award, and has been interviewed for the "Best of Our Knowledge" on NPR.
