Dickinson Summer and Short-Term Programs Refunds

Policy/Procedure

REFUND POLICY FOR EARLY WITHDRAWAL ON SHORT-TERM PROGRAMS:

A student's date of withdrawal is determined by either:

- 1. The date the student notifies CGSE in writing of their decision to withdraw, or
- 2. The date the student is officially dismissed from the program

A student who withdraws on or prior to the 45th day before the start of the program will receive a 100% refund, less the non-refundable confirmation deposit.

A student who withdraws after the 45th day prior to the program start date, but before the actual start of the program, will receive an 80% refund of the Comprehensive Fee (Tuition + Program Fee) less the non-refundable confirmation deposit.

After the program starts, the student forfeits 100% of the Comprehensive Fee (Tuition + Program Fee).

In all cases, Dickinson retains the right to deduct non-recoverable costs from any applicable refund. These would include costs, incurred after the confirmation deposit is received, for hotel, excursions, and transportation costs, etc.

DICKINSON SUMMER AND SHORT-TERM FINANCIAL AID REFUNDS

For students receiving Financial Aid, the financial aid refund rules apply as stated in the Dickinson College Bulletin under the <u>Dickinson College Refund Policy</u>. It is important to understand that since the financial aid refund is calculated using different methods, the refund to the student account may not fully cover the required refund to the financial aid programs. Therefore, the student may end up owing funds to Dickinson College after the refund to the financial aid programs has been made.
