MONTH: June

THEME: Summer Safety / Summer Fun

Family participation: Please remember to be safe this summer. Talk to your children about summer safety such as wearing sunscreen to protect their skin from the sun, wearing a helmet when riding a bike to protect their heads, proper play ground play to protect themselves and others that may be playing also, never enter a pool without an adult with them. Have a great summer and please let us know if and when your child will be off for a vacation by filling out the vacation sheet on the door.

OBJECTIVES/GOALS:

During the month of June, we will be talking about how to have fun in the summer as well as how to stay safe. Topics that we will talk about, are sun safety, pool safety, playground safety. We will also talk about the fun things that you can do outside in the summer that you can not do in the winter. We will start having water play days, so keep an eye out for information about bringing in swim suits, protective water play shoes and a towel.

COGNITIVE/PROBLEM SOLVING

- *figuring out how to get sheet onto cot
- *getting undressed and dressed to go outside to play in the water
- *finding the letters in your name 1.1.PK.D

ACTIVITIES:

- *bear counters

- *where are the letters in your name

- *naming ways to stay safe when playing in the sun

- *being able to place sleep toys in cubbies upon arrival

- *cutting
