#### **Non-Confidential Resource**

**Title IX Office** – Individuals may speak with the Title IX Coordinator, who understands the sensitivity of reports and will uphold your privacy, however, the Title IX Coordinator cannot guarantee full confidentiality. The Title IX Coordinator typically only shares information on a "need to know" basis; for example, with other staff who support the Title IX Coordinator in addressing or resolving sexual and gender-based allegations. The Title IX Coordinator can be an excellent resource to review the College policies with you and answer any questions about the process that you may have.

#### **Advisor of Choice**

**Can I bring someone to the meeting with me?** For sexual and gender-based allegations, the Complainant and Respondent have the same opportunity to be accompanied to any related meeting or proceeding by an advisor of their choice.

#### Amnesty

Will I be in trouble if I was drinking underage or using drugs when the incident happened? Dickinson College encourages individuals to report incidents of sexual or gender-based misconduct when they occur. The individuals who act responsibly by reporting incidents of sexual or gender-based misconduct will typically not face College disciplinary action for their own drug or alcohol possession or consumption in connection with the reported incident.

#### **Retaliation is Prohibited**

## What if I fear retaliation or someone has retaliated against me?

Retaliation is strictly prohibited against anyone who reports an incident of sexual or gender-based misconduct, or who participates in any College process related to such an incident. If you have any concerns about retaliation, you should discuss them with the Title IX Coordinator immediately.
