Setting the Stage – A potential postseason bid could be on the line as the Devils welcome the Bears of Ursinus to Biddle Field for the regular season finale. Muhlenberg clinched the conference title last week, leaving a three-team race for sole possession of second place. Both teams enter the game with 5-2 conference marks, while Gettysburg, also at 5-2 heads to Franklin & Marshall.

The teams meet for the 79th time with Dickinson holding a 42-30-6 lead in the series. The Bears broke a five-game losing streak to the Devils last season, claiming a dramatic overtime win in Collegeville.

Last Week- The Red Devils rolled to a 41-14 homecoming win over Juniata. Ian Mitchell completed 14-of-16 passes for 246 yards and four touchdowns. Chris McInerney was on the receiving end of three touchdown passes on the day. He finished with nine catches for 128 yards. Patrick O'Connor made four catches for 120 yards, scoring from 68 yards out.

Will Scott tallied seven tackles, including five solos and one-for-loss. He returned an interception 56 yards to the Juniata one yard line, setting up a touchdown for classmate Aren Johnson. Eric Dube and Paul Titchenell each added seven tackles as well. Dube also recorded 2.5 tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble.

Unbeaten Muhlenberg handed Ursinus a 31-7 defeat to capture the CC title. The Bears were held to just 96 total yards on the day.

Last Year - The Bears spoiled the Devils bid for a perfect conference record with a 31-24 overtime win in Collegeville. Clay Merris made a spectacular diving catch in the endzone to tie the game with 1:19 remaining. The teams traded scores all day, going into halftime tied 14-14.

Matt Torchia threw for 136 yards and two touchdowns while running for 42 yards and another score. Ryne Cantwell rushed for 87 yards on just 13 carries and Chris McInerney added 65 yards receiving.

Eric Dube matched a game-high with 11 tackles. Eric Hertrich tallied 3.5 tackles-for-loss, including 2.5 sacks. The Devils held Ursinus to just 18 yards rushing.

Ted Wallingford connected with Brandon Evans on a 25-yard pass in overtime to give the Bears the win.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach **Darwin Breaux** (West Chester, '77) holds a 94-58-1 record in his 15th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made four post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season the past three years.

Today's Game

The Series - Today's game marks the 79th meeting in the series. The Devils hold the advantage 42-30-6 and have won five of the last six games. The Bears last win in Carlisle came in 2001. Both teams made to the post season last fall. The Devils earned an automatic bid to the NCAA playoffs while Ursinus went to an ECAC Bowl game.

Offense- The Devils racked-up 493 yards of total offense last week, pleasing a capacity crowd on homecoming weekend. Sophomore Ian Mitchell completed 14-1of-16 passes for 246 yards and four touchdowns. He rushed for an additional 51 yards, earning Centennial Conference Player of the Week honors.

Mitchell becomes the second Dickinson quarterback to amass over 2,000 total yards in a single season. Matt Torchia set the school record with 2,074 last season.

Senior Chris McInerney added to his school records, setting the single season mark with 699 receiving yards. He holds the school mark for receptions in a season with 68. That is the ninth highest in CC history. He holds the school record for career catches with 135 and ranks second in receiving yards with 1,528.

Defense- The Red Devil defense was relentless on Saturday, holding Juniata scoreless until the fourth quarter. They held the Eagles to just 70 yards rushing, forced two fumbles and returned three interceptions for 98 yards.

Senior corner Will Scott recorded seven tackles, including five solo stops. He picked-off a pass and went 56 yards to the Juniata one yard line.

Eric Dube also tallied seven tackles, including 2.5 for losses and a sack. He added a pass break-up and forced fumble on the day. Dube is the school record holder for career tackles with 367. He set the school mark with 173 solo tackles and ranks second in tackles-for-loss with 49 in his career.

Mike Maxwell tallied six tackles and added a 34-yard interception return. Greg Lord did a little of everything on Saturday, breaking up two passes and returning an interception. He also played special teams and had two carries on offense for 25 yards.

Eric Hertrich was fighting double-teams all afternoon. He broke through for four tackles and had a huge sack for a loss of 11 yards. Paul Titchenell also had a solid performance with seven tackles.

Special Teams- Senior puner Aren Johnson had a relatively slow afternoon when it came to punting. The Devils were fine with having to punt just twice in the game. Johnson averaged 38.5 yards on his two attempts. He added to his

school record for career yardage, becoming the first Red Devil to reach 7,000. He has punted 202 times in his career for 7,200 yards.

First-year Gordon Craig has hit 22-of-23 extra-points this season. He hit 21 straight to start his collegiate career.

Scouting Ursinus - The Bears were also in the Centennial Conference title hunt until last weekend. Muhlenberg clinched the title with a 31-7 victory in Collegeville.

Ursinus has posted 15 wins over the past two seasons. That is the school's second highest two-year total since 1999-2000 when they won 18.

QB Nick Dye has thrown 14 touchdown passes this fall- the fourth highest single season total in Bear's history. Aaron Harper needs 121 yards to break into the top five for rushing at Ursinus.

The Bears rank second in the CC in scoring defense, pass defense and total defense, and rank third in rushing defense.
