Setting the Stage - Dickinson heads to Ursinus for the season finale on Saturday. The Red Devils put some big numbers on the board at Juniata and will look to do the same this week. The Devils erupted with 34 points in the second quarter to take a 41-13 lead at halftime. The Eagles made a valiant comeback but the Devils won the shootout 53-41.

Ursinus suffered a 45-8 defeat to #6-ranked Muhlenberg last weekend. The Bears scored on an 82 yard kick-off return. Billy Stolle led the defense with 12 stops and an interception.

Last Week - The Red Devils and Juniata combined for a Centennial Conference record 1,207 total yards. Dickinson put up a CC record 34 points in the second quarter. Ian Mitchell threw for 253 yards and two touchdowns. He also ran for two scores, covering 109 yards on the day.

Gregory Lord ran for a career and game-high 182 yards and a touchdown. Pat O'Connor caught 10 passes for 165 yards, becoming the school record holder in career receiving yards with 1,849.

A.J. Reisig led the defensive effort with 10 tackles, an interception, forced fumble and four pass breakups.

Ursinus was held to -16 yards rushing and 150 overall against the sixth-ranked Mules. QB Matt McCugh completed 10-of-16 passes for 75 yards.

Last Year - Michael D'Amico rushed for 127 yards and Ian Mitchell ran for 126 as the Devils put 28 points on the board in the first half. They went on to win the game 35-20 as the Bears scored a pair of late touchdowns. Pat O'Connor caught six passes for 80 yards and two scores.

The Devil defense held the Bears to just 74 yards rushing. Eric Dube tallied 12 tackles and two sacks. Ben Hargrave added eight tackles, a forced fumble and an interception.

Nick Dye completed 22-of-33 passes for 240 yards and two touchdowns in the last meeting. Mike Weyrauch caught six passes for 85 yards.

The Breaux Report

Dickinson head coach Darwin Breaux (West Chester, '77) holds a 101-62-1 record in his 16th season at the helm of the Red Devil football program. He has one of the highest winning percentages in the history of the program and holds the record for most wins by a Dickinson football coach.

Dickinson has won four Centennial Conference titles and made five post-season appearances under Breaux's direction. His 1994 team set a school record with the college's only 10-0 season, earning him AFCA (American Football Coaches Association) South Region Coach of the Year honors.

Breaux's teams have always been known for a traditionally strong option-oriented running game and hard hitting defense. The Red Devils have balanced the attack, setting school records for passing yards in a season in three of the past four years.

The Series - The Devils meet the Bears for the 80th time. Dickinson holds a 43-30-6 advantage in the series with the home team winning the last three outings.

Milestones - Ian Mitchell broke the school record for career total offense with 4,770 yards while becoming the first Dickinson quarterback to rush for over 1,500 yards and throw for over 3,000.

Pat O'Connor added the career receiving yardage record to a long list of accomplishments this season. He had 115 catches for 1,849 yards.

Offense - The offensive line continues to provide a protective environment for Mitchell, allowing a conference-low six sacks this fall. The Devils lead the CC in rushing offense and pulled into third in scoring last week. They rank third in total offense and second in pass efficiency.

Mitchell leads the way in total offense, averaging a CC-best 264.7 yards per game. He is second in pass efficiency and fourth in passing yards per game.

O'Connor leads all receivers in receptions and yards at 8.2 for an average of 133.8 yards per game.

Gregory Lord had a huge day in Huntingdon, rushing for a game and career-best 182 yards.

Defense - The Red Devils are tied among at the top of the CC with 20 sacks this season. Tredell Johns leads the Devils with 3.5 sacks on the year. He has a team-high 8.5 tackles-for-loss.

Ben Hargrave leads the Devils and ranks fourth in the conference with 85 tackles. Kevin Wood has recorded 73 tackles while Michael Dalton has 69 stops on the year.

Senior A.J. Reisig tallied 10 tackles last week, forcing a fumble, breaking up four passes and intercepting a pass.

Special Teams - O'Connor also leads the Centennial in all-purpose yards, averaging 192.6 per game.

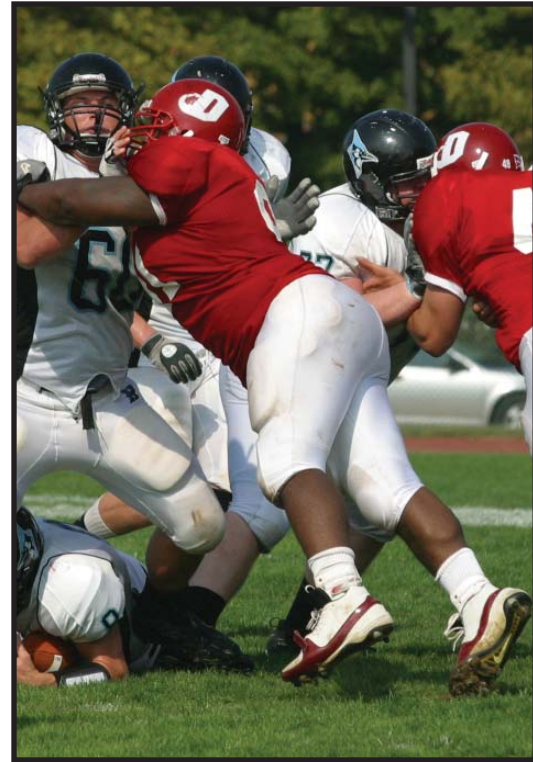
Gordon Craig hit 5-of-7 extra points and converted a pair of field-goals from 27 and 38 yards out at Juniata.

Matt Stark bombed a 48 yard punt and averaged 37.2 yards per kick last week.

Scouting Ursinus - Who will start at quarterback is a big question for the Bears. Nick Dye is slated to call signals but Matt McHugh completed 10-of-16 passes last week.

Mark Jaskowski is the number four rusher in the CC at 99.0 yards per game but is questionable as well.

The Bears are last in sacks against, which could be beneficial to the Devils.
