

HEALTH CARE DURING THE TIMES THE HEALTH CENTER IS CLOSED

During the summer, and during holiday breaks, the Health Center is closed except during those weeks summer school is in session.

Health Center Hours during summer school: Monday – Friday 8:30 – 1:30

If you are on campus working or doing research, and need medical assistance during the time we are closed, there are several options.

- 1) Call NurseLine, our 24/7 nurse advice service by dialing their toll free number 1-866-409-1859. They can help you determine what level of care you need, or if you can provide self-care. Their number is also on the front page of the Health Center website.
- 2) Sadler Health Center - 100 N. Hanover Street, Carlisle, PA. Tel: 717-218-6670.
 - a. Sadler Health Center will see Dickinson College students only during those periods of time the Health Center is closed, which includes winter break, spring break, the weeks between graduation and summer school, and the weeks following summer school until the Health Center opens again for the fall semester.
 - b. When you call for your appointment, you must identify yourself as a Dickinson College Student.
 - c. Must show Dickinson College ID at time of visit.
 - d. Must go to appointment 30 minutes early to complete required paperwork.
 - e. Must pay in cash, check, or credit card (no Discover or American Express).
 - You will get a receipt that you can send to your insurance company for potential reimbursement. Sadler Health Center will not bill your insurance.
- 3) US Health Works is a walk-in clinic located at 1124 Harrisburg Pike. Their phone number is 245-2411. Their hours of operation are 8:00 am – 6:00 pm Monday – Friday. This is a good alternative to the hospital emergency room which can be very costly if your condition is not truly an emergency
 - a. Please call ahead to see if they take your insurance
 - b. If they do not take your insurance, you can still be seen there, but will have to pay for the visit with cash, check or credit card. Be sure to get a receipt that you can send to your insurance company.
 - c. If your insurance is an HMO, or managed care organization, you may be required to get pre-authorization from your primary care physician or the insurance company prior to getting any medical services. Please read your insurance card and call them if you are not sure what to do.
- 4) Carlisle Regional Medical Center emergency department.
 - a. The emergency department should be used if you feel your medical condition is truly an emergency. Again, you can call Nurse Response and they will help you determine the level of care you require.
- 5) If true emergency
 - a. From on campus, call DPS at 717-245-1111 for help and transportation. This is your primary emergency contact.
 - b. From off campus, call 911.
