This is the third year Prescott College will be collaborating with Camp Augusta to offer a credit bearing class in group facilitation. We have been successfully using Camp Augusta's online training module, along with remote one on one mentoring, to provide students a professional training opportunity in group facilitation, non-violent communication, and other successful feedback strategies shown to enhance group process. This 4 credit, college course has been of particular interest to our students in the Adventure Education and Human Development departments. We have learned a few things along the way and made some useful improvements that have enhanced student success. This year we are offering a "hybrid" version of the course which will allow students to meet together on-campus for group discussions, along with completing the online modules. I am excited to see how this pans out.

An important bonus to this training course is that successful students will be encouraged to apply to work at Camp August and likely obtain employment that immediately following summer.
