Expectations of House Members

- Be kind/polite to roommate(s), housemates, guests, cleaning lady, and maintenance
- Clean up after yourself; Wash your dishes, don't leave stuff lying around the house, and don't leave stuff in the shower
- Save electricity; Turn off the lights when leaving a room, and turn hallway lights off during the day, don't leave water running to brush teeth
- Be mindful of others
 - If an individual causes problems and is not respecting the space in which
 they live or any other person with whom they live, the House Manager
 must address the issue and work with that individual on ways in which
 they can change in order to meet the house expectations

Positions within the House

- House Manager: Position is made clear in advance
 - Sends all the texts and emails containing information necessary for all houseguests to know
 - Is the individual who calls house meetings (if and when necessary)
 - Listens to what everyone has to say, and makes decisions based off of what they think is best for everyone in the house
 - Will do whatever necessary to help the houseguests and the house stay a part of Delta Nu
- Every other person in the house does not have a position given to them by the sorority, but if the house manager feels it is necessary to designate roles to members in the house that is up to them

Meetings

- House meetings occur whenever the House Manager feels they are necessary
- Occur in the 'Pink Room' a.k.a. The Living Room; That way there is enough space for everyone/everyone can feel comfortable speaking
- All house guests attend meetings, unless they have a legitimate conflict which they inform the house manager of ahead of time; House manager leads the meetings
- House manager address issues they feel need to be addressed and then listens to any input that the housequests have; Vote on issues when necessary
- The point of house meetings: Keep everyone on the same page, make sure everything in the house is going smoothly, and solve any issues or conflicts

Application Process

- Junior members in Delta Nu are asked to fill the house first, but it is open to sophomores; They state who they want to live with and then room choice: First come, first serve
- No actual application process

• Community Standards

 Decided by every House Manager after being discussed with the members in the house; Process for dealing with someone who is not maintaining community standards is decided by the House Manager

Programming

- Delta Nu events are held in the house
- Houseguests who are not in Delta Nu are made aware of the events that will be held in the house in advance and asked to not enter the Pink Room when those events are being held
- Delta Nu events are funded and taken care of by Delta Nu
