*Course Selection

International Fellows may take one course per semester. Final permission must be obtained from the professor after you have been admitted to the program. Instructions to find the course schedule can be found on this link: <u>https://banner.dickinson.edu/pls/PROD/bwckschd.p_disp_dyn_sched</u>.

Note: Courses at Dickinson College are taught in English except for foreign language courses. Writing assignments and exams are rigorous. Consider your comfort level with English as a method of instruction when choosing courses. For advanced language courses, you will be asked to take a placement exam to determine your current level. For beginner language courses, you will not need to take a placement exam.

International Fellows may take a course for credit or audit. If taking the course for credit, students are expected to complete all coursework and will be assigned a final grade/mark by the professor. If auditing the course, students are expected to contribute to the class through active participation but are not always expected to submit all assignments or take exams. Ask your professor as each professor has different parameters to determine what constitutes a successful audit.

Student Agreement

By submitting this application, the applicant agrees with the following:

- International Fellows are expected to participate actively in class, regardless of whether the course is being taken for credit or audit. If, during the semester, the International Fellow can no longer attend class, the International Fellow must contact the Registrar's Office to officially withdraw.
- To remain eligible for the scholarship for a second semester, the International Fellow must successfully complete the first semester course. For credit courses, successful completion means receiving a grade of "C" or above.
- Communication from campus professors and staff is sent by email to the International Fellow's Dickinson email address and through the College's online (Gateway) portal. It is the Fellow's responsibility to check their Dickinson email and Gateway account regularly.
