Sustainable Transportation Policy – Fuel Choice

In an effort to reduce carbon emissions in association with the college's carbon neutrality commitment, the college places a strong preference for fuels that have environmental benefits, while also giving consideration to financial costs.

Accordingly, the following policy regarding transportation fuels is to be followed whenever possible by all departments utilizing college owned vehicles. The college's tanks at Facilities Management will follow this policy.

- Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) Vehicles using **Gasoline**: Fuel purchased shall be E10, which has an emissions factor which is below that of standard gasoline. (These figures include biogenic CO2 emissions).
- ICE Vehicles using **Diesel**: Fuel purchased shall be at least 20% biodiesel, which has an emissions factor that is lower than standard diesel fuel. (These figures include biogenic CO2 emissions).
- ICE vehicles that are flex-fuel vehicles will utilize E85 fuel when it is possible to do so.
