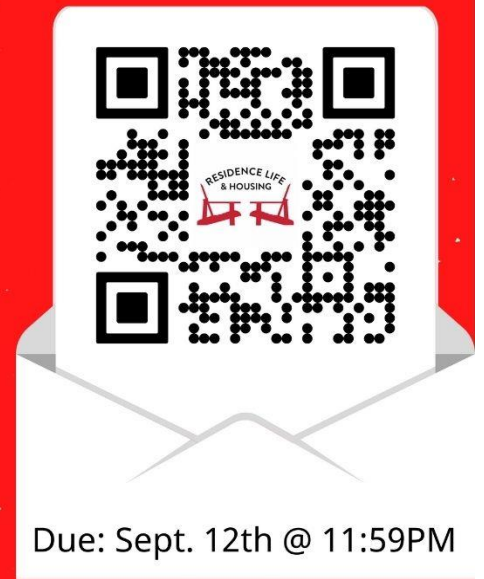

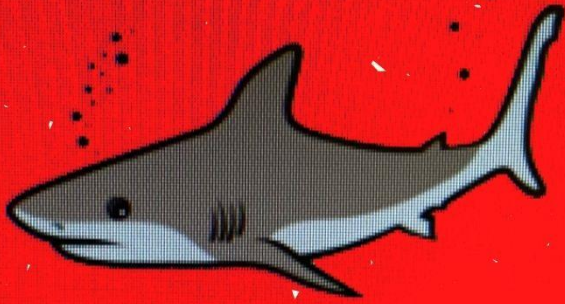

## President



- Lead various meetings and serve as the main liaison between the Community Board and Residence Life
- Provide leadership for the members and for programming

## VP

- Presiding over meetings of the community board when the president is unable.
- Attending executive board meetings led by the president.

## Secretary

- Attending and recording meeting minutes of the community board
- Sending recorded meeting minutes and discussion topics to community board members and the Area Coordinator
- Meeting with the Area Coordinator two (2) times per fall semester and three (3) times per spring semester.

## General Member
