Testing for Employees

On-site COVID-19 testing for employees is no longer offered at Dickinson College.

Employees who have been exposed to COVID-19, or who feel symptomatic may obtain testing at local pharmacies, <u>Sadler</u>

<u>Health Center</u>, <u>UPMC</u>, <u>PennState Health</u>, other healthcare provider locations, or through athome test kits available at retail locations.

At-home tests from the USPS are now available. *The program has been reinstated as of September 25, 2023. For more information on testing options, please visit <u>covid.gov/tests</u>.*

At-Home Test Kits & Pharmacies:

Some insurance plans cover the cost of at-home test kits. If you have insurance through Dickinson College, tests kits are available at no cost using your Meritain Health member card containing your <u>Optum Rx prescription benefit</u> information.

Test kits may be ordered online for pick-up or delivery. You can also pick up a test kit at your pharmacy. For more information, please visit <u>Optum Rx</u>.

*Please be aware that if you order test kits through an online pharmacy, you may have up-front charges, and can submit a claim to <u>Optum Rx to request</u> reimbursement.
