This is a summary of the annual report for the DICKINSON COLLEGE CONSOLIDATED HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFIT PLAN, (Employer Identification No. 23-1365954, Plan No. 515) for the period July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Dickinson College has committed itself to pay the following types of claims incurred under the terms of the plan:

INSURANCE INFORMATION

The plan has contracts with Ace American Insurance Company, Continental American Insurance Company, Hartford Life and Accident, Reliance Standard Life Insurance Company, United Concordia Insurance Company and Vision Benefits of America to pay the following types of claims incurred under the terms of the plan:

All health, dental, vision, life insurance, long-term disability, temporary disability, accidental death and dismemberment (AD&D), dependent, supplemental life and vol AD&D.

The total premiums paid for the plan year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 were \$813,819.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending June 30, 2022, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$488,237 and the total of all benefit claims paid under the "experience-rated" contracts during the plan year was \$356,129.
