- COVID-19 Vaccines/Booster administered by your primary care provider, will remain at a \$0 cost share.
- **COVID-19 Lab Tests** will remain at a \$0 cost share.
- Office visits, Urgent care, Telemedicine, and ER visits both in and out-of-network when there's an associated COVID-19 test done within two days before or two days after the visit, will remain at a \$0 cost share.

Optum Rx manages the pharmacy benefit for your plan. There will be no changes to the current PHE coverage and there are no out-of-pocket costs for the below:

- COVID-19 Vaccines/Booster will be available at a network pharmacy at a \$0 cost share.
- Anti-viral Treatments COVID-19 oral treatments Paxlovid™ (nirmatrelvir/ritonavir) and Lagevrio™ (molnupiravir) will be available at a network pharmacy, at a \$0 cost share.
- Over the counter (OTC) at home COVID-19 tests will remain at \$0 cost share for up to 8 tests per covered member per month.

How do I get reimbursed for OTC at-home COVID-19 tests purchased at an online retailer or other stores?

- If you purchased FDA-authorized COVID-19 tests at a retail store or online retailer you can be reimbursed for up to 8 tests per covered member per month. You will need copies of your purchase receipt(s). Complete one form per covered family member.
