

National Science Foundation Data Management Plan – A Guide for Dickinson Principal Investigators

All NSF proposals must include a Data Management Plan (DMP), **no longer than two pages**, which describes the Principal Investigator's plans for managing data and sharing the products of research or shows that such plans are not needed. DMPs will be submitted through Research.gov as a supplementary document. Research.gov will not accept proposals that do not have a DMP. DMPs will be reviewed as part of the intellectual merit or broader impacts of the proposal, or both, as appropriate.

DMPs illustrate the intention of full and open sharing of all data with the research and applications communities, private industry, academia, and the general public—a result of the Federal Funding Accessibility and Transparency Act.

Data management requirements and plans specific to the Directorate, Office, Division, Program, or other NSF unit relevant to a proposal are available at <http://www.nsf.gov/bfa/dias/policy/dmp.jsp>.

Please note that if a specific program solicitation provides guidance on preparation of DMPs, such guidance must be followed. If specific guidance for a particular program is not available, the requirements set forth in the current NSF Proposal & Award Policies & Procedures Guide apply.

Once Dickinson PIs have drafted DMPs for their projects,* the Sponsored Projects Office should be contacted **early** to allow time to provide estimates of costs related to the implementation of the DMP. These costs can be added to the NSF budget.
