Campus & Community Outreach Coordinators

A non-voting member of Carlisle Borough Council who serves as a representative voice for students on council. The goals of this position are to connect Dickinson College students with Carlisle and to further strengthen the relationship between the college and the community.

Marketing & Communications Coordinators

Manages multiple social media; designs and implements high-impact graphic and written materials; produces print, digital, and video content; and implements creative marketing to increase awareness of and participation in a variety of CCLA programs and events.

Student Dialogue Associates

Work alongside Dickinson's community of faculty, staff, and students to incorporate and facilitate dialogues to promote for a more de-polarized world by placing dialogic tools into the hands of the broader Dickinson community.

Carlisle Borough Ambassador

Responsible for organizing campus and community initiatives, including Days of Service. Helps to lead Change Makers Club as a hub for social change and supports the Pathways Initiative to promote long-term ethical service.

Community Engagement Fellows

The CEF program provides students with a paid two-year internship working with a local organization while participating in ongoing civic leadership education. The CEF position is filled through a distinctive application and selection process.

Community Engagement Fellows Program Coordinators

This specialized position is designed for a current CEF/CEF alumn(a/us), who serves in a crucial leadership role of the Community Engagement Fellows (CEF) program.

Voter Engagement Coordinators

Develops and leads campaigns and events to increase voter engagement at Dickinson College. In coordination with Dickinson Votes, the coordinator serves the campus by enhancing nonpartisan efforts related to voter education, voter registration, and voter turnout.



Service Trip Leader Corps

Works as a team to coordinate 3-4 domestic and/or international service trips over academic breaks. Oversees fundraising, program development, and outreach effort related to these service trips. Works creatively to increase and support service participation, especially by targeting first-year students and other groups.
