Register for an Account

Go to the web address: www.artstor.org

1. Hit "Go" (on the far right)
2. Register for an account
3. Fill in your information including school email and password
4. Hit "Submit"

You now have an account that you can view images on and off campus (remote)

ARTstor Introduction: *Navigation Bar, SubHeadings and Keyword Searching*

Navigation Bar: Find, Organize, Share, Display Options and Tools

Search Functions: Keyword Search or Advanced Search Options

Advanced Search Options to narrow search:

- Use drop down box
- Depending on the case, use "NOT"
- Place quotation marks around phrase (e.g. "abstract expressionism")
- Use Dates
- Make a selection within the Geography, Classification, and Collections area boxes

Advanced Search Options to broaden search:

- Use drop down box
- Use "AND", and "OR"
- Use * or \$ at the end of search terms instead of using plural endings (e.g. chair*, design\$)
- Select broad range of dates or do not fill in date information
- Select many or no boxes within Geography, Classification, and Collections

Image Group Search:

- Login to your account
- Open Image Group
- Know the Image Group you are searching for
- Double-Click to open

Exporting to PowerPoint (one image or several images):

Once you have found the image(s) that you need you can:

- Double-Click on the thumbnail
- Zoom in to a particular detail
- Pan around image
- Print
- Download individual images or export entire image groups

QTVR files (QuickTime Virtual Reality files):

- QTVRs are panoramas from a central viewpoint
- Click on QTVR icon and this will launch the image in QuickTime. (Note: in order to view these files you need QuickTime Player to be installed.)
- Once the QTVR file has uploaded, click in the window and drag the pointer towards the direction you want to view. (ie. Dragging the pointer right, the panorama will go to the right.)
- Use the zooming icon features to zoom in or out
