Please read all information carefully to complete the form. All international student applicants regardless of intended or current visa status, must document their ability to meet all education and living expenses for one full academic year to demonstrate that they would be eligible for an I-20 form to obtain a student visa through completion of this form and the submission of supporting documents such as bank statements, proof of income, and documentation of other support. Applications will not be considered complete and reviewed for admission until this form and the supporting documentation has been submitted.

Final 2027-2028 costs are officially set by the board of trustees each year in late February. We anticipate estimated costs to increase anywhere from 3.5-5%.

Important notes for financial aid applicants:

- Dickinson provides international students with need-based aid based on a family's demonstrated financial need.
- Dickinson does not provide full scholarships (sometimes referred to as "full ride scholarships") that cover the total cost required to obtain a student visa.
- Like many U.S. colleges and universities, Dickinson does not provide funding for all costs required to obtain a student visa. At Dickinson, this includes the cost of mandatory health insurance (\$2,500), one-time fees of \$125, and any travel anticipated above \$1,000 per year are not included in determining financial aid for international students. Dickinson financial aid does not provide funding for these items. Students must be able to fund these costs without merit scholarship or need-based financial aid from Dickinson College.
- Dickinson requires an equal contribution each year of attendance. If your contributions listed are different across academic years, your contribution will be averaged over all four years.
- To secure your visa, if admitted, students will need to document that they have the funds to pay their expected contribution based on the information provided on this form.
