

DICKINSON BUILDINGS AND ELEVATOR ACCESSIBILITY

ACADEMIC/ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDINGS *(See next page for access to residential buildings)*

Building	Wheelchair accessible?	Elevator Access?	Instructions
Admissions	Yes	No	There is a ramp to the main entrance and the 1 st floor is accessible.
Allison	Yes, for some rooms, but not the 2 nd floor (see details)	No	The Community Room is accessible via a slightly steep ramp at entrance off of the parking lot (north side of the building). The Great Hall is accessible via a ramp off of Mooreland Avenue (on the west side of the building). To move between the Community Room (basement) and the Great Hall (1 st floor), you'll need to go outside and re-enter the building through the entrance on Mooreland Avenue or off of Morgan Field. The 2 nd floor is not currently accessible via wheelchair.
Althouse	Yes	Yes	There are two accessible entrances to Althouse. At the front of the building (the side facing Bosler), the ramp is to the right of the steps. The elevator is located just inside the front door to the right. The entrance at the rear of the building (the side facing the Quarry) is at ground level, and there is a single-user lift to the basement level. Turn left and go down the hall to get to the elevator on the right side, just past the stairs. There is a lift in Althouse 106 to access the front of the room. If you will be instructing or presenting in this room and need to use the lift, contact Facilities at (717) 245-1212 to ensure that the key is available to you.
Asbell Center	Yes	No	Only the 1 st floor is accessible, but the bathroom and kitchen are not.
ATS	Yes	Yes	Enter via ramp on the north side. The elevator is on the right side of the lobby.
Biddle House	Yes—1 st floor only	No	The ramp is located on the Britton Plaza side of the building. If you need to meet with anyone whose office is not on the 1 st floor, you should request that they meet you in the Biddle House library (located on the 1st floor)
Bosler	Yes	Yes	Enter via the ramp on the College Street side of the building. Go into the first floor lobby and the elevator is at the end of the lobby.
Dana	Yes	Yes	(This building is currently out of use.)
Denny	Yes	Yes	You will need to allow extra time to access Denny, as you will need to take a single-user lift to get to the internal elevator. The lift is located on the north side of the building (to your left when facing Denny from West St.). The lift goes down to the basement. Make sure the outside door is fully closed or the lift will not function. Once at the basement level, proceed straight ahead, and the elevator is down the hall on your left.
East College	Yes	Yes	Accessible entrances are on either side of the building. If you enter via the ramp at the rear NW corner (on the Stern side), proceed through the door straight ahead and the elevator is on the right.
Hartman House	No	No	If there are to be events here, Facilities would make available a portable ramp for access to the first floor.
HPH	No	No	The Historic President's House is under renovation to be fully accessible.
HUB	Yes	Yes	Enter via the ramp on Britton Plaza. The elevator is located between Mather's Theatre and the Box Office.
Kline—Athletic Center	Yes	Yes	Elevator is access via the main Cherry St. entrance. All of the Kline is wheelchair accessible, with the exception of the loft spaces where football offices and dance studio are located.
Kaufman	Yes	N/A	Ramps are at both Louthier entryways. Kaufman is a one-story building.
Office of Equity and Inclusivity	No	No	This building is only accessible via stairs. The irony that the Office of Equity and Inclusivity is an inaccessible building is an unfortunate problem that needs to be addressed. For now, directors are prepared to meet at alternative locations.
Old West	Yes — only the lower level	No	There is a ramp on the west side of the building leading to the lower level (home of Access and Disability Services). If you have a meeting with someone whose office is above that floor in Old West and inaccessible to you, you should ask if they could reserve a conference room in the lower level for that meeting.

Building	Wheelchair accessible?	Elevator Access?	Instructions
Rector (James/ Tome Science Complex)	Yes	Yes	Enter via the main entrance on Louthier St. Go straight; elevator is located at the opposite end of the lobby. (If you need to get to the Animal Care lab in the basement, that's a separate elevator on the west side of the building.)
Stern	Yes	Yes	When on the academic quad and facing Stern, the access ramp is at the western-most entrance (on the left side) of the building. Upon entering the building, turn right. The elevator is on the left, just past room 102.
Weiss	Yes	Yes	There's a fairly steep ramp at the rear right of the building that leads down to the accessible entrance. The elevator is located at the end of the short hallway on your left.
Wellness Center	Yes	Yes	The elevator is located in the lobby when first entering the Wellness Center.
Waidner Spahr Library	Yes	Yes	The ramp to front door is on High Street. The elevator faces the entrance.
