

EPIPEN Auto-Injector and EPIPEN Jr Auto-Injector Directions

- First, remove the EPIPEN Auto-Injector from the plastic carrying case
- Pull off the blue safety release cap



Hold orange tip near outer thigh (always apply to thigh)



Swing and firmly push orange tip against outer thigh. Hold on thigh for approximately 10 seconds.
Remove the EPIPEN Auto-Injector and massage the area for 10 more seconds

- Remove caps labeled "1" and "2."
- Place rounded tip against outer thigh, press down hard until needle penetrates. Hold for 10 seconds, then remove.




SECOND DOSE ADMINISTRATION: If symptoms don't improve after

10 minutes, administer second dose:


Unscrew rounded tip. Pull syringe from barrel by holding

blue collar at needle base.

- Slide yellow collar off plunger.
- Put needle into thigh through skin, push plunger down all the way, and remove



Adrenaclick™ 0.3 mg and Adrenaclick™ 0.15 mg Directions



- Remove GREY caps labeled "1" and "2."
- Place RED rounded tip against outer thigh, press down hard until needle penetrates. Hold for 10 seconds, then remove.



Once epinephrine is used, call the Rescue Squad and request an ambulance equipped with epinephrine and a responder the Emergency Room for at least 4 hours. trained to administer this medication. Take the used unit with you to the Emergency Room. Plan to stay for observation at
